Key Responsibilities

Based in Kuala Lumpur, the Alpha for Youth & Campus Senior Development Coordinator will have the following responsibilities:

1. Development Work for Alpha Youth (English)

- Co-responsible for the creation of strategy and plans for English Alpha for Youth, with the coaching of the Assistant Development Manager, and responsible for the effective execution of these strategies and plans.
- Grow in strategizing for the expansion and retention of Alpha for Youth (English), with support and guidance from the Assistant Development Manager.
- Conduct introductions and training sessions, while providing ongoing support to students and leaders involved in Alpha for Youth (English).
- Build and lead a team of coaches aligned with A.U.G.H.T. values, ensuring the execution of a coaching strategy that empowers coaches to train other groups to run Alpha.
- Place special emphasis on the development and execution of the Alpha in Schools framework to reach more students in educational institutions.

2. Development Work for Alpha Campus (English)

- Co-responsible for creating strategy and plans for English Alpha for Campus, with the coaching of the Development Manager, and accountable for their successful execution.
- Build and nurture relationships with both potential and existing Alpha users, guiding them through the various stages of the Church Engagement Framework (CEF).
- Conduct introductions and training sessions, offering support to churches and other organizations regarding Alpha for Campus.
- Establish partnerships with complementary university ministry organizations, such as FES, Campus Crusade, and church university ministries, to foster collaboration.
- Build and lead a team of coaches that reflect A.U.G.H.T. values and ensure the coaching strategy is implemented effectively, allowing coaches to train others to run Alpha.

3. Cross-team Support and Event Collaboration

- Collaborate with other teams and participate in cross-functional events, contributing to the overall growth and impact of Alpha in Malaysia.
